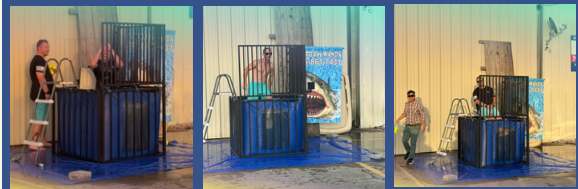
To celebrate its arrival, the Seneca is available throughout the summer for **\$370 per hour**.

We look forward to welcoming our first class in August and beginning this exciting new chapter.

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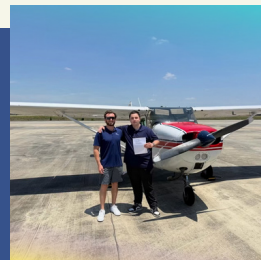
